<b>Volume</b> <b>20</b>	<b>0-5 points</b> Too soft, can't hear at all.	<b>6-10 points</b> Can hear, but not loud enough.	<b>11 -15 points</b> Loud enough and we can all hear perfectly.	<b>16-20 points</b> Volume was perfect and added increases or decreases for emphasis.
<b>Clarity</b> <b>30</b>	<b>1-7 points</b> Mumbled a lot. Could not understand.	<b>8-14 points</b> Mumbled a bit. Hard to understand all the words.	<b>15-21 points</b> Pronounced all the correctly.	<b>22-30 points</b> There was an extra crispness to the pronunciation.
<b>Fluency</b> <b>30</b>	<b>1-7 points</b> Choppy, needed to stop and figure out words	<b>8-14 points</b> Stopped now and then to work on a word.	<b>15-21 points</b> Smooth like a river, knew every word.	<b>22-30 points</b> Flowed faster or slower depending on the story's mood.
<b>Expression</b> <b>15</b>	<b>1-4 points</b> Didn't change voice at all: monotone	<b>4-8 points</b> Read in a sing song or did not change voice very much.	<b>9-12 points</b> Changed their voice to make it interesting the whole time.	<b>13-15 points</b> Sounded very professional. This reader should be on stage.
<b>Posture</b> <b>5</b>	<b>1 point</b> Held the paper in front of their face. Did not stand tall.	<b>2 points</b> Sometimes held the paper too high, sometimes stayed tall.	<b>3 points</b> Held the paper properly and stood tall all the time.	<b>4-5 points</b> Moved comfortably during the reading...not stiff.
